As you are all aware, South Africa and the rest of the world is under siege by the Coronavirus (COVID-19), a virus which has resulted in countries being forced to take drastic measures to contain its spread and thus reduce its fatal consequences. South Africa is one of those countries having declared the COVID-19 pandemic a national disaster and as of last night instituted a countrywide lockdown from Thursday 26 March 2020 until 16 April 2020.

Consequently, Rare Plastics will cease all business activities, including manufacturing, sales and logistics, from 12h30 on Thursday, 26th March 2020.

As mentioned, we anticipate on re-opening on 17th April 2020, but this will be subject to any future directives from the South African Government.

Current projects with manufactured stock can be collected until 12h30 on Thursday, 26th March 2020.

Delivery dates in respect of new orders will be communicated on the lifting of the lockdown and re-opening of business, at this stage expected to be 17th April 2020.
